Journal of Economic Theory Symposium on Financial Economics

The *Journal of Economic Theory* plans to publish a symposium on financial economics, especially as related to the current crisis. We invite papers from all areas of financial economics, including ones containing empirical work. Papers must meet the standards of the *Journal of Economic Theory* and will be refereed according to the usual *JET* procedures.

This will mark the twentieth anniversary of the European Summer Symposium in Economic Theory, held every July in Gerzensee at the Study Center of the Foundation of the Swiss National Bank. The *JET* symposium will be coordinated with the 2011 Gerzensee Symposium, but we also invite submissions from those who did not participate in the 2011 Symposium. Indeed, participation in the Gerzensee Symposium is neither necessary nor sufficient for inclusion in the *JET* symposium.
